Eligibility of Applicants:

- All participants must have a valid MMA license.
- All participants Must be 16 years old or above.
- All participants must be available and willing to attend regular training at less once per week
- Anyone wishing to become Maiwand assistance Instructor for the first time will need to attend the Diploma Level-1 Certificate in Coaching.
- All participants must follows MMA Instructor Syllabus book
- All participants must have at least 2 years current and relevant training experience in any martial arts.

Course Duration:

- 20 weeks, 1 hour classes per week = 40 hours of MMA teaching instruction.
- We are seriously advising all MMA students to attend all three Levels Diplomas courses. Before we issues your full instructor qualifications certificate.

Code of Conduct during Course

Maiwand Martial Arts will expect that all instructors will operate in an honest manner. This extends to all dealings inside and outside the organisation. I will learn the following and benefit from making it part of my training course and future development at MMA and in my daily life.

ENTERING THE CLASS

- All participants must salute to the Instructor as soon as they enter the hall. Or students leave the training hall, before exiting the door, they should turn and face the instructor, (It does not matter if he is not looking at them) salute to the instructor and exit the hall.

CLASS RULES PROCEDURES

- EVERYONE must sign their course attendance sheet when entering to the class.
- During coaching training session Work hard you enjoy yourself.
- Look after the training course equipment and your own equipment at all times.
- Maintaining a safe and appropriate distance between each other.
- Keeping a written record during your 20 weeks training course.
- Tell your instructor immediately if you are injured or unwell.
- DO NOT TOUCH ANY of the weapons unless specifically asked to do so by the course Instructor.
- Only qualified course instructor have the authority to supervise all weapons practice sessions. Not the students.

Course Attendance:

- Please arrive early for class – preferably 10 minutes before class start time.
- Be properly dressed before entering the training room.
- Dress code shall be sensible and Look after your uniform and your MMA training equipment.
- Advise your course Instructor in advance if you cannot make your session. Do not advise your instructor on the day.
- Please continue to attend your training course on a regular basis to be eligible for Diploma level-1 Certification.

Students Behavior:

- Listen to the instructor/coach carefully when he's teaching.
- Watch the instructor /coach carefully when he's performing the techniques.
- Ask you instructor before leaving a class for any reason (e.g. toilet, drink, etc)
- When told to STOP you must STOP.
- Course candidates must behave in an appropriate way at all times, both in and out of the room. This means acting with respect and discipline, and not acting in a way that could bring the MMA school into disrepute.
- The good name of Maiwand Martial Arts shall not be brought into disrepute at any time. If to do so results in membership being terminated.
- Course candidates must show great respect for the training session and make every effort to be on time for classes.
- ANY cameras or mobile phones with cameras taking any pictures or video are not permitted so anybody who taking any pictures or video without permission will be asked to leave the class.
